LAVES – More Safety for the Consumer

What can I still eat? News reports about BSE, Dioxin or Avian Influenza have made consumers insecure. That is why Lower Saxony has taken action in 2001 and the Lower Saxony State Office for Consumer Protection and Food Safety – LAVES – was founded.

In LAVES all tasks of the consumers health protection are focused on minimizing risks and to continually encourage consumer confidence. Six official institutes belong to the LAVES organization throughout Lower Saxony. The head office is located in Oldenburg.

What is the aim of LAVES?

LAVES was founded with the objective to determine health risks for consumers at onset, as well as to efficiently and promptly fight them. Reliable controls, safe analysis methods and independent and objective sources of information all belong to the most important instruments of LAVES.

By the interactive connection of all expertise, more safety and transparency in the food chain "from stable to table" can be achieved.

What are the LAVES Tasks?

In LAVES around 1.000 employees are engaged in consumer protection. The tasks of LAVES are diverse. They include:

- the execution of all official testing of food, feed, animals and daily consumption goods (such as flatware, toys and cosmetics)
- the control of feed companies
- veterinary drug surveillance and the minimization of antibiotics in livestock production
- the consultation and support of local government authorities in food surveillance, cross-border food trade of animal origin, animal health and animal welfare
- the approval of feed and food companies (e.g. carcass disposal establishments, fish-processing plants, slaughter houses, daries)
- market control
- monitoring of organic inspection bodies
- animal testing
- enquiries according to the consumer information act
- risk communication
- anonymous reporting office

LAVES is Lower Saxony's contact point for:

- the EU-Rapid Alert System for Food and Feed (RASFF)
- the Central Office "G@ZIELT", which is monitoring internet trade and which is located at the Federal Office of Consumer Protection and Food Safety (BVL)
- the central Office of food fraud (BVL)

Consumer protection based on expertise in

- analytical testing
- control
- consulting and information

Who is integrated in LAVES?

On 1 July 2001, the former authorities of the State for Food and Veterinary Diagnosis were merged to establish the new LAVES. In 2003, the newly founded Feed Institute was affiliated and in 2004 the Institute for Apicultural Research also joined the group. The departments of LAVES give their support to the responsible local authorities in relation to food control, the combat of animal diseases and the removal of animal by-products. As well as answering all questions pertaining to animal welfare and Inland Fisheries. They control veterinary home dispensaries, the minimization of antibiotics in livestock production, animal feed economy, ecological agriculture, as well as adherence to quality specifications and grade of goods of agrarian products.

The concepts of consumer protection in Lower Saxony are provided by the Ministry for Nutrition, Agriculture and Consumer Protection. The coordination of these concepts is a task of LAVES. Then the coordinated concepts are transferred by the local governmental authorities to the local districts.
